### Champagne

1. **Castellane Brut NV, 12% Vol. Laurent Perrier- France** £ 34.00  
*Pale gold in colour with a steady stream of fine bubbles fresh fruits and brioche nose. Rich and crisp clean finish and part of the famous house of Laurent Perrier.*
2. **Taittinger Brut Reserve NV, 12% Vol. - France** £ 51.00  
*Vinified from the finest pressings of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes. The Reserve is dry light and elegant including citrus, peach and brioche notes on the nose.*
3. **Ruinart Blanc de Blancs NV, 12.5% Vol. - France** £ 59.00  
*Bright, golden yellow, slightly lemony, fine bubbles.. Floral nose, good intensity and elegant. Delicate sensation with a long finish. Part of Dom Perignon.*
4. **Bollinger Grande Annee 1997/99, 12% Vol., - France** £ 78.00  
*This blend expresses the House's excellence and is the fruit of the style, the exceptional terroir and winemaking methods particular to Bollinger. Rich and complex aromas.*
5. **Dom Perignon 2000, 12.5% Vol., - France** £145.00  
*Each vintage offers a new aspect of Dom Perignon, reflecting an assemblage that is a unique act of creation by Richard Geoffroy the winemaker. Complex structure and full of sensation.*
6. **Castellane Rose NV, 12% Vol. Laurent Perrier - France** £ 41.00  
*This wine is a blend of pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier. It has a marvellous salmon colour and a fruity and flowery bouquet with delicate aromas of strawberries. Fresh and full.*
7. **Ruinart Rose NV, 12.5% Vol., - France** £ 59.00  
*A fine, elegant champagne with the distinctive Ruinart taste due to a high concentration of Chardonnay grapes. A beautiful colour of pinkish gold, Smooth, fruity wine with plenty of body.*
8. **Prosecco Castello 4357 Brut NV, 11.5% Vol., - Italy** £ 17.00  
*Castello 4357 is the address of Fabiano and now relates to the 'Extra Dry Label'. Straw yellow with extra green hints, soft and persistent. Floral and fruity perfume and a soft round palate.*

### House Wine, white

9. **LL Blanc Chardonnay NV P. Marchand 12% Vol., - France** £ 13.95  
*Made by a well known house in Chambertin Philippe Marchand A weighty palate, mineral texture combined with a slightly toasty Edge. Crisp flavours with a touch of apples and apricots.*
10. **Pinot Grigio Villa Borghetti 2007, 12% Vol., - Italy** £ 14.95  
*Produced in the Verona region using 1005 Pinot Grigio grapes. The wine is a pleasant style, balanced, harmonious, fruity, crisp, fresh and easy drinking with food or as an aperitif.*
11. **Laroche Sauvignon Blanc 2007, 12% Vol., - Australia** £ 14.95  
*This wine come from the Laroche winery in the Languedoc area. Aromatic and full of freshness. Clear and very pale yellow, with hints of elderflower and gun flint. Vivacious and refreshing*

### House Wine, red

12. **LL Rouge 12% Vol., - France** £ 13.95  
*Marchand produces all Burgundy wines and these grapes are for this Pinot Noir as well. Fine nose of strawberry and raspberry with floral notes. Well-balanced acidity and subtle tannins.*
13. **Miralvalle Tempranillo 2005, 13.5% Vol., - Spain** £ 14.95  
*Part of the El Coto winery. This red wine has a ripe reddish colour. A sensation of vanilla and fresh tobacco under an elegant base of spices and ripe black fruits.*
14. **Merlot Laroche 2007, 13.5% Vol., - France** £ 15.95  
*100% Merlot from the region of Montpellier. deep purple, Well rounded, powerful and spicy with hints of ripe pepper And fruits. structured, soft tannins and a delicate hint of oak.*

### House Wine, rose

15. **El Coto Rose 2007, 12.5% Vol., - Spain** £ 14.95  
*Made from Tempranillo and Grenache fro the Rioja Alavesa. Strawberry and raspberry flavours, powerful aroma with hints Of petals. Refreshing fruit flavours with subtle nuances.*

## White Wine

### Europe white

16. **Chablis Simonnet Febvre 2006, 13% Vol., - France** £ 24.50  
*Part of Louis Latour. A harmoniously clean and handsome wine. Robust notes of citrus fruits, apples and pears. An excellent balance between fruity characters and fresh acidity.*
17. **Pouilly Fume Château Langlois 2007, 12.5% Vol., - France** £ 27.50  
*The Bolinger family invested in Château Langlois in the 1970s. Made From white Sauvignon only, pale yellow with green reflects. Fresh and intense citrus, fruits, almond witz a note of gunflint*
18. **Sancerre Le Manoir 2006, 12.5% Vo. – France** £ 28.50  
*Pale green. Herbal, tangerine nose with a hint of apple. Fuller and richer on the palate than the nose would suggest. almost tropical fruit flavour.*
19. **Pouilly Fuisse Louis Jadot 2006, 13% Vol., - France** £ 29.50  
*One of Louis Jadot's biggest selling wines worldwide. Showing aromas of ripe peaches and apricots and a palate t with depth and weight consistent with the best wines of the appellation.*
20. **Gavi de Gavi Volpi 2007, 12% Vol., - Italy** £ 23.50  
*Made from the Cortese grape. The wine treats the nose with cxitrus and floral notes and captivating hints of apricot, peach and pineapple. Fresh, persistant lime and lemon aftertaste.*
21. **Pinot Gris Adam 2006, 13% Vol., - Alsace** £ 23.50  
*Fruity dry white. A full bodied white with rich honeyed character and an enticing smoky flavour. A wonderful wine with food, in Alsace served with all kinds of meat dishes.*
22. **Rueda Marques des Riscal 2007, 13% Vol., - France** £ 14.95  
*Fermented in stainless steel with no maturation in wood. The colour is pale straw and the wine has an intense aroma of ripe fruit with floral notes. Dry, crisp with a clean finish.*
23. **Mr. J. Gruener Veltliner 2007, 12.5% Vol., - Austria** £ 22.50  
*The loess and weathered primary rock soils of the Kamptal offer the ideal geological pre conditions for the regions most characteristic wine. Fresh and spicy structure & peppery note.*

### New World white

24. **Last Ditch Viognier d'Arenberg 2007, 13.5% Vol. -Australia** £ 24.50  
*Youthful, almost clear, appearance with edges of green tint. Floral, excotic character suggesting apricot stones, nectarine and white peach notes. Grippy tannins and acidity.*
25. **Groote Post unwooded Chardonnay 2007, 13.5% Vol.-S. Africa** £ 23.50  
*A full and ripe style this year with layers and layers of flavours. Ripe Melon on the nose and an unusual aspect of marmalade and preserved ginger offset with a firm acid structure.*
26. **Jibe Sauvignon Blanc 2006, 12.5% Vol.,- New Zealand** £ 24.50  
*An explosive bouquet of lime and guava. Elegant and racy on the palate with vibrant flavours of tangerines and Granny Smith apple. Surprisingly creamy mouthfeel and mineral flavour.*
27. **Marmesa Chardonnay 2005, 13.5% Vol., - California** £ 23.50  
*The wine is fresh, aromatically complex, fully ripe and opulent This wine is lees aged for a rich mouthfeel. Honeyed notes and tension between the floral and fruity aspects. Herbs & citrus.*
28. **Zerk Semillon Viognier 2006, 13.5% Vol., -Australia** £ 23.50  
*Aromas of tropical fruit salad with hints of guava, freshly cut Hay and subtle toast. Soft, clean and crisp with a creamy Texture and a long smooth finish. Complex and full flavour.*
29. **Ravalan Sauvignon Blanc 2007, 13.5% Vol., - Chile** £ 18.50  
*A wonderful intense herbaceous character complimented by the delicate tropical flavours typical of the Sauvignon Blanc grape. Balanced fresh and elegant, Delicious with seafood.*
30. **Chenin Blanc Pecan Stream 2006/07, 12.5% Vol.- S. Africa** £ 19.50  
*Beautiful straw colour witz apple green tint. Aromas of water melon, pear and ripe apricots. Rich textured flavours. Crisp with a delicious lift at the end, and a dry, green aftertaste.*
31. **Pinot Grigio Santa Rosa 2006, 13.5% Vol.,- Argentina** £ 17.50  
*A light, gentle nose. Crisp, attractively zingy example filled with Ripe apple and pear like fruit. Quite full on the palate with A richness that grows.*

## Red Wine

### Europe red

32. **Fleurie Caves de Fleurie 2006, 13% Vol., - France** £ 24.50  
*The wines of Fleurie very quickly develops a fresh, floral and fragrant style. Not as light and delicate as some suggest, the wine has a vivid and intense red robe with aromas of raspberry and strawberry*
33. **Tiefenbrunner Lagrein 2006, 13% Vol., - Tyrol / Austria** £ 23.50  
*Deep garnet red in colour, with a delicate bouquet showing the cherry note characteristic. Subtle wood tones compliment it's full and round full flavours. Compact tannins with acidity.*
34. **Châteauneuf du Pape La Bastide 2004, 12.5% Vol. France** £ 33.50  
*The powerful nose shows aromas of intense cassis and damsons. The medium to full-bodied palate has flavours of garrigue spice, liquorice, cherry jam and red currants.*
35. **Château Teynac St. Julien 2001, 12.5% Vol. - France** £ 32.50  
*A wine of ruby colour of good intensity. The nose is intense of ripe fruit like blackcurrant and blueberries as well as plums, Roses and pepper. Supple, fat rich attack with fresh acidity.*
36. **Gevrey Chambertin Marchand 2004, 12% Vol.,- France** £ 44.50  
*Classique red Burgundy from the Cote de Nuit. Silky and soft With aromas of strawberries and spicy cherry fruit. With maturity, aromas and flavours of leather, liquorice and game develop.*
37. **Cune Reserva Rioja 2004, 14% Vol., - Spain** £ 23.50  
*Intense, ruby red in colour with rich, deep aromas of bramble, autumn fruits and fine oak. The palate is fine, complex and long with balanced tannins and excellent bright finish.*
38. **La Mota Barbera d'Asti Superiore 2003, 13.5% Vol., - Italy** £ 21.50  
*Dry, full, rich with ideal balance of acidity and tannin. Intense, complex combination of mature fruit and wood. Ruby red with perceptible garnet rim.*
39. **Valpolicella Classico Ripassato 2003, 13.5% Vol.-Italy** £ 23.50  
*Full bodied and harmonic. Good ruby colour with an intense fruity bouquet reminiscent of ripe cherries and figs. Well structured with a long and persistent finish.*

## Red Wine

### New World red

40. **Rosso Classic FF Coppola 2005, 14% Vol.- California** £ 19.50  
*Zinfandel gives sweet, juicy flavours, intense aromatics. Syrah provides the colour, lush texture and sweet fruit flavours. Cabernet Sauvignon provides structure, weight and flavour.*
41. **The Very Sexy Shiraz Cloof 2006, 15% Vol. -S. Africa** £ 22.50  
*Grown in vineyards that have been described as 'Shiraz Heaven', This wines luscious fruit was accessorised with the very best French oak making a package, so appealing and seductive.*
42. **Paper Road Pinot Noir 2006, 13.5% Vol.,- New Zealand** £ 25.50  
*Pinot Noir with a good bouquet of cherries and plums. Flavour of tobacco and spice complement a rich silky palate with a purity of fruit and finely integrated tannin structure.*
43. **Bobby Burns Shiraz 2005, 14.5% Vol., - Australia** £ 24.50  
*Plum and black berry fruits with hints of mint ground spice and soy. Complex characters of leather and tobacco. Well integrated oak and soft tannins, lingering finish.*
44. **De Martino Legado Syrah Reserva 2004, 14.5% Vol.-Chile** £ 23.50  
*A wonderful nose of blueberries and black cherries making notes of chocolate and cedar. This leads to black fruit, cinnamon and a long concentrated finish. Well integrated oak.*
45. **Santa Celina Malbec 2007, 13.5% Vol., - Argentina** £ 19.50  
*Deep red colour with violet hues, an intense aroma of ripe red fruits typical of the variety. Vanilla and tobacco aromas imparted by oak. Full bodied, notable texture and long finish.*
46. **Punto Alto Cabernet Sauvignon 2006, 13.5% Vol.- Chile** £ 22.50  
*An intense ruby coloured wine with violet nuances. Aromatic framework with fresh notes of ripe, red and black fruits. Slightly minty, exotic and vegetal notes of bay leaves and pepper.*
47. **Merlot Groote Post 2006, 14.5% Vol., - South Africa** £ 23.50  
*All the characteristics one could seek in a Merlot are in abundance. Hints of mint and smoked beef on the nose. plum and chocolate on the palate with firm tannins.*

### White

48. **Chassagne Montrachet L. Jadot 2001, 13.5% Vol, -France £49.50**  
*A staple from Château, this bright Chassagne has good minerality, notes of apple and pear along with a balanced core of acidity. An impressive Village wine.*
49. **Lady A Fume Blanc 2005, 13.5% Vol., - Tasmania £ 47.50**  
*Pale straw with tinges of green. Grapefruit and citrus with gooseberry and passion fruit with a hint of lanolin and toasted characters balanced with a crisp natural acidity.*
50. **Goosen Sauvignon Blanc 2008, 12% Vol – S Africa £ 32.50**  
*Produced at the furthest eastern vineyard in South Africa. Cool climate control, subtle tropical undertones good acidity and long finish.*
51. **Chablis 1<sup>er</sup> Cru Montmains Laroche 2005, 13% Vol.,- France £37.50**  
*Les Montmains showing all the elements of a classic Chablis Gunflint structure fruit and harmony. Bright, straw, gold colour. It's bouquet has lemony hints with a touch of vanilla oak.*

### Red

52. **Château Palmer Margaux 1999, 12.5% Vol., - France £195.00**  
*95 Parker points. It boasts an opaque blue / purple colour as well as sweet aromas of liquorice, jammy cassis, smoke, lead pencil and minerals. Maturity 2006 – 2025.*
53. **Real de Asua Cune Imperial 1995, 13.5% Vol., - Spain £ 89.00**  
*Brick – ruby red in colour with a complex nose of black fruit, mint, toasted oak and balsamic aromas. Full-bodied with lush tannins and flavours of cherry raspberry, leather and earth.*
54. **The Goose Expression 2005, 14% Vol., -South Africa £ 69.00**  
*Retief Goosen proudly expresses his first world class wine with this 2005 Vintage and Decanter Bronze Medal winner made from Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon.*
55. **Nectar Dei Chianti Riserva 2004, 12% Vol., - Italy £ 44.00**  
*Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah & Petit Verdot. Deep red with purple shade followed by spice and liquorice. Rich tannins and a long caressing finish. Tried by the Pope!*
